Please be prepared to work on the dates and times you sign up for. **Failure to turn in this form or to appear for a date you obligate yourself to will result in a charge of \$100.00 per meet session to your account to cover lost revenue.** Specific jobs will be assigned when you arrive on the date of the meet.

Official/Stroke & Turn Judge – This person will attend all hosted swim meets (and may attend some away meets) working as an official, ensuring swimmers follow all stroke rules. Training entails taking and passing a written test as well as on-deck “shadowing”.

I want to take a moment and explain why we require our parents to volunteer at our hosted meets at the TAMU Rec Center. If your children have ever been involved in any other sports or clubs (i.e. scouts) you know that they are required to do fund raisers, like sell candy or magazines. Organizations do this to raise money for activities, etc. for the kids. Our Club is the same way, but we ask you to contribute your time to help us run the meets we host. We make money from these meets by charging entry fees to the swimmers and through concessions and program sales. The proceeds from these meets go back to every single swimmer in our Club, which is why we ask/require everyone to help out. The proceeds are used for things such as:

- running Intrasquad Meets (we have to pay for timing systems, lifeguards and pool rent)
- awards for Intrasquad Meets, including ribbons, pins and personal best time treats
- supplies (paper, labels, etc)
- year end awards for the kids
- social events for the kids (like our Halloween party and annual lock-in event)
- practice equipment (i.e. kickboards, fins, etc.)
- free entry fees for our swimmers at Club hosted meets

Without the proceeds from these meets we would not be able to afford to do these things for the kids. The jobs at the meets are all very easy and 95% of them require no training whatsoever. Jobs like hanging up meet results or heat and lane assignments in the appropriate area (called a runner), selling programs or concessions and checking credentials are examples of what our parents are asked to do.
